**Formal Dining vs the Bar's Casual Dining:** The club offers formal dining Tuesday to Thursday and Friday nights upon reservation, so please do call or email our front desk to let them know in advance if you wish to make a reservation. Formal dining will usually be offered in the Library unless an event is taking place there. Casual dining is offered in the bar with rapid service to enable you to return to your office in short order. Breakfast, is served from 7:00 to 9:30 am, Lunch from noon to 2:30 pm and Dinner from 5pm to 9:00 throughout the weekdays. New fall menus begin mid-September.

**Sharing costs** for meals and entertainment: - it is simple for your guests to pay for all or part of the meal or drinks—when signing the check ask them to add their name and credit card details and a telephone number in case we need to contact them after the fact.

## October 6th, 2011—Election Night Returns

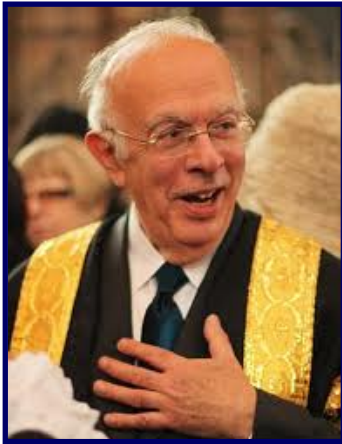
