

WHITE WINE FEATURES BY THE GLASS

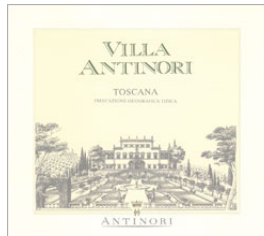


W120 Codorniu Brut Clasico (Spain) \$8/Glass
Excellent as a summer aperitif, this sparkling wine is made from the same blend of grapes used by the creator of Codorniu in 1872 and balanced to a dry finish.

W74 Antinori Bianco 2008 (Tuscany)

\$31/btl \$7/glass \$21/carafe

With golden straw-like hues, this wine has an intense yet refined aroma with floral and aromatic notes of yellow rose and is made from pinot grigio, pinot bianco and trebbiano grapes.



W64 Kangarilla Road Viognier 2006 (McLaren Vale)

\$34/btl \$8/glass \$24/carafe

Lively aromas of sweet honeydew melon, ginger and citrus conserve with citrus and citrus blossom and hints of zesty oiliness so characteristic of Vionier. "Kudos to owner/winemaker Kevin O'Brien for fashioning these fine as well as realistically priced wines. Given the exceptionally high quality of Kangarilla Road's offerings, prices are extremely fair." **Robert Parker.**



W79 Chateau Graviille-Lacoste 2008 (Bordeaux) \$44/btl \$10/gls \$30/carafe

Simply fun to drink with all the hallmarks of fabulous French whites, this wine is made from Semillon with some Sauvignon Blanc grapes.



W102 Wilhelm Walch Pinot Grigio Marat 2007 (Alto Adige, Italy) \$34/btl \$8/gls \$24/carafe

Taken from a single estate vineyard, using selected grapes to give outstanding quality. A classic example of the style of the most famous wine from Alto Adige. This noble wine, with its pale straw shade, has an extraordinary elegant bouquet, full bodied but soft & slightly dry taste.

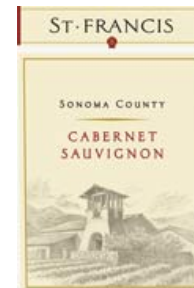


R116 El Chaparral de Vega Sindoa Bodegas Nekeas 2008 (Navarra, Spain) \$32/btl \$8/gls \$24/carafe

"Inky ruby. Exotically perfumed bouquet displays black raspberry, cherry compote, licorice and dark chocolate, plus a sexy floral overtone. Fresh, focused red and dark berry flavours are given depth by a note of bitter chocolate and framed by silky tannins. Finishes with very good clarity and mineral snap, with the black raspberry note repeating. Year in and out this is a superb value". **90 points – Steven Tanzer's International Wine Cellar**

R72 St. Francis Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 (Sonoma County, California) \$48/btl \$10/gls \$30/carafe

Ripe, rich, chewy blackberry and black currant flavors lead onto this wine's lush, velvety palate followed by impressions of cedar, tobacco, spice and vanilla with supple, round tannins on the finish.



R11 Perrin Réserve 2007

\$25/btl \$7/gls \$21/carafe

A beautiful deep red hue that seems almost opaque. The nose shows caramel and spices that mingle with red berry fruit. The palate is full and deep, with fine tannins and good length.



R42 McLaren Ridge Shiraz 2005 (McLaren Vale) \$37/btl \$9/gls \$27/carafe

"Heather and Peter Oliver have released their first wine, a Shiraz, with the help of Nigel Rayner, Brian Light and David Ridge. Get some before they even have a cellar door and before anyone finds out just how good it is for its asking price. Planted a decade ago the vines finally produce fruit that just couldn't be ignored, expressing the McLaren Vale terroir to the fullest with 'Cherry Ripe' forward aromas of cherries, chocolate and earthy, peppery flavours with tight tannins and a long and lively finish." **Franz Scheurer, Australian Gourmet Pages**
